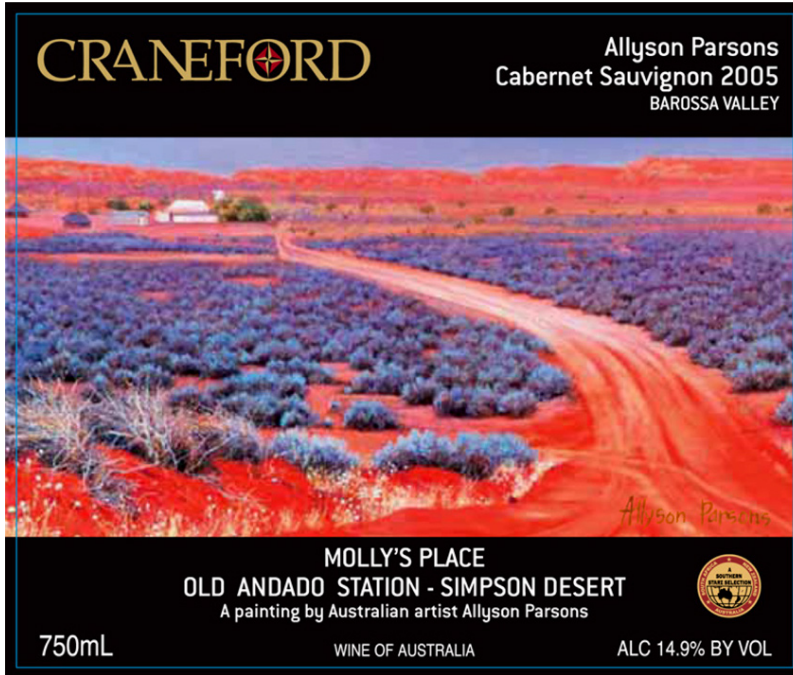

Tasting Notes

89 pts Robert Parker, Jr. Wine Advocate #167

The deep ruby/purple-tinged, medium to full-bodied 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Allyson Parsons exhibits pure black currant and blackberry fruit along with notions of damp earth, herbs, and spice. With excellent ripeness, decent acidity, and silky tannin, it should drink well for 10-12 years.

Food Accompaniments

Rich meats: Duck, Veal, Game. By the glass.

Winemaker Notes

Color: Black, purple hue Nose: Blackcurrant, blackberry, spearmint, spice, earth. Palate: Incredibly soft yet a powerful complex depth of fruit flavors abound. Blackberries, blackcurrant, spice and earth with hints of spearmint and tobacco leaf. The palate has good length with lingering flavors. All fruit tasted in the vineyard prior to picking. A small addition of acid added at the crusher. Wine pumped over only and a minimal amount of the pressings added back.
