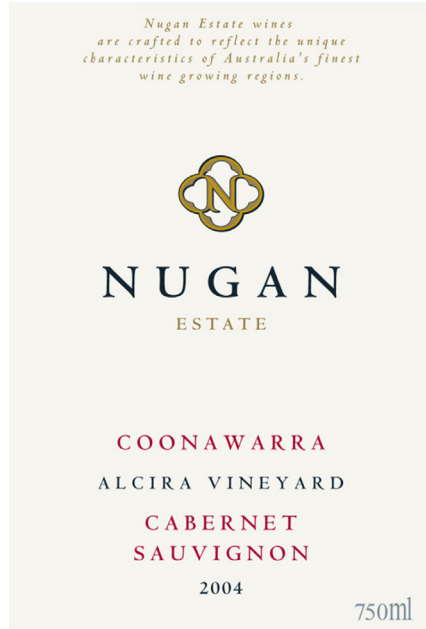

Tasting Notes

88 pts Robert Parker, Jr. Wine Advocate #167: From Coonawarra, the 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon Alcira Vineyard exhibits minty cassis notes along with toasty new oak (which kept my score from going higher) and beautiful flavors, medium to full body, sweet tannin, and an elegant style. Enjoy it over the next 7-8.

Food Accompaniments

Thyme and garlic roasted duck, warm lamb fillet salad or glazed veal medallions

Winemaker Notes

Deep crimson in appearance with youthful purple hues. Aromas of cassis, mint and eucalypt with spicy, earthy tones complimented by savoury oak. Intense flavours of rich chocolate, vibrant ripe cassis and velvety tannins beautifully melded with herbal nuances of mint and fennel, with subtle oak accompaniment.

This Cabernet Sauvignon was sourced from the Coonawarra region of South Australia. Upon yeasting, the vinimatic was rotated four times daily until dryness, pressed, seeded with MLF bacteria and sent to new and seasoned French Oak barrels for maturation. Post fermentation/s the wine was racked and returned every 2 months and adjusted when necessary prior to final blending and bottling.
