Tasting Notes

The impressive 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon (100% Cabernet Sauvignon aged in used American 300 liter hogsheads) exhibits a deep ruby/purple color, loads of fruit, silky tannins, and abundant volume and richness without being heavy or pruny. It should be drunk over the next 3-4 years

Food Accompaniments

Enjoy it with cheese and red meat dishes.

Wine Makers Notes

Vines are hedged trellised, exposing the grapes to the sun to achieve maximum ripeness. All vines are irrigated from the nearby Loddon river with ground level mini sprays. Red grapes are planted on heavy clay soil with pieces of limestone present in the soil.
