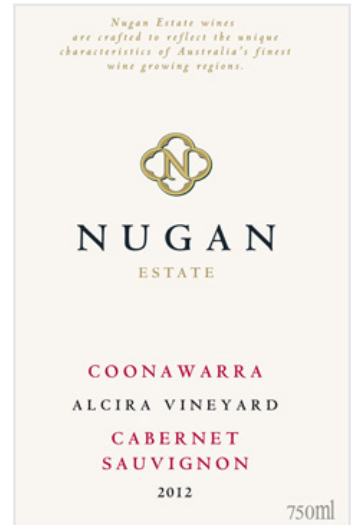

Viticultural Practices: This Cabernet Sauvignon was sourced from the Coonawarra region of South Australia. Upon yeasting, the vinimatic was rotated four times daily until dryness, pressed, seeded with MLF bacteria and sent to new and seasoned French Oak barrels for 24 months maturation. Post fermentation the wine was raked and returned every 2 months and adjusted when necessary prior to final blending and bottling.

Wine Makers Notes: Deep crimson with youthful purple hues. Aromas of cassis, mint and eucalypt layered with spice and earth. Intense flavours of rich chocolate, vibrant ripe cassis and velvety tannins beautifully melded with herbal nuances of mint and fennel, with subtle oak accompaniment.
