




# Wildberry Estate - Two Passions Cabernet Sauvignon 2013

**Viticultural Practices:** Most people know Damon Eastuagh for his legendary big wave surfing talents. Few are aware of his other passion - winemaking. When he's not in the ocean riding the giants, you'll find him in our cellars making our fantastic, award winning wines.

This delicious Cabernet Sauvignon comes from specially selected parcels grown on our Wildberry Estate vineyard 0- located in the heart of the famous Margaret River sub-region of Wilyabrup. Bunch selection in the vineyard is followed by open tank ferments an regions hand plunging before being basket pressed into French barrels (20% new). 15 Months later Damin does the assemblage and after minimal fining and filtration, the wine is bottled to represent the truest possible expression of this internationally acclaimed wine region.

**Wine Makers Notes:** Intense blackcurrant and blackberry sweetness lift out of the glass over layers of black olive and molasses richness. The palate is concentrated, and textured showing chewy tannins well integrated with subtle amounts of French Oak. This wine will benefit from cellaring for 5-10 years.

**Score(s): 90 pts Tanzer/Vinous** - Brilliant ruby. High-pitched aromas of blackberry, cassis and candied flowers, with a spicy overtone gaining power as the wine opens with air. Juicy and energetic on the wpalate, with gently sweet flavors of dark berry preserves, licorice pastille and spicecake complemented by a zesty touch of cracked pepper. Shows very good focus and vivacity on the finish, which features smooth tannins and a lingering floral quality. -- Josh Raynolds

**90 pts James Suckling** - This is cool stuff here with lavender, rosemary and currant character on the nose and the palate. Full body, polished and refined tannins and a fresh finish. Shows the salty, seaside and currant flavor of the region. Drink now.
