Viticultural Practices: Chenin Blanc is harvested from a farm which borders Agter Paarl in Wellington, from dry farmed vines of 20 to 40 years old. This wine should be drunk within 3-4 years of the vintage.

Winemaker Notes: A lively wine with zippy flavors of creamy pineapple, pink lady apples and melon. The wine has a lovely texture with a long finish and enough acid to keep it really fresh and vibrant.

Score(s): 89 pts John Platter - Dry, crisp and fresh, unwooded from Swartland hugely over-delivers, its peach and chamomile perfume leading to citrus and stone fruit flavors in abundance, lingering on finish.
