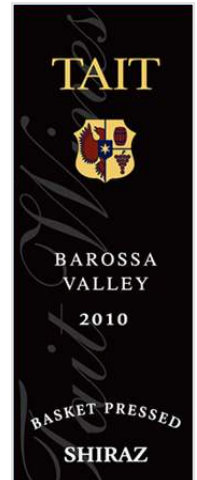




Tait Basket Pressed Shiraz 2010

Viticultural Practices: It is our philosophy that all quality wine starts in the vineyard. The Barossa fruit we use is always very low yielding and produces highly concentrated flavours and aromas. We use traditional winemaking methods including open fermentation, extended maceration and basket pressing - we feel our wines display our uncompromising pursuit of excellence.

Wine Makers Notes: Has a nose and palate characterized by layers of juicy blackberry and plums infused with chocolate and sweet vanilla oak finishing with fine oak tannins.

Food Accompaniments: Meat, cheese.

Score(s): 94 pts Robert Parkers The Wine Advocate (LPB) - Deep garnet in color, the 2010 Shiraz Basket Pressed is a little closed though reveals really lovely aromas of red and black fruits preserves, dark chocolate and cloves with hints of dusty earth and violets. Rich and full in body, the grainy tannins and freshness provide structure through the long finish.
